#### From the Rector

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Having returned from Israel in March, the Easter readings will come alive in a new way for the group of 35 who travelled for the 10 day tour. We will walk with Jesus into Jerusalem from the Mount of Olives; we will be with him in the Garden of Gethsemane and feel the great human sense of betrayal when even his closest friends deserted him. Then the wonderful explanation at Nazareth village of what crucifixion meant for its victims will give the group a sense of being able to enter more fully into the drama and glory of these few days.

Most of us go through life not knowing what lies around the next corner, and if we feel or have an idea that we need to take action to protect ourselves, we immediately put a plan into place. Not so with Jesus—he came for a purpose and that is what we celebrate at Easter. Paul O'Connell sings a most revealing song which you can listen to by googling 'He paid a debt he did not owe'. It also says 'I owed a debt I could not pay'. That is the reason for Easter.

A HUGE thank you to all who came to our Coffee Morning on 16th. Just before the snow hit us for a 2nd time. We raised over €700 which will be divided between Sr. Mary Killeen who works with street children in the slums in Mukuru and Brighter Communities, a charity that helps communities to help themselves by teaching and empowering communities to become self sufficient. Eimear is already in Londiani, Kenya teaching Lifeskills - a programme specifically designed to educate girls so they can work their way out of poverty. ### Invest in girls

#### HELP GIRLS GO TO SCHOOL

In Kenya, girls who do not complete secondary school have on average 8 children in their lifetime; those who do complete secondary school have just 2 or 3.

#### IMPROVE MATERNAL HEALTHCARE

84% of babies are delivered without a skilled birth attendant leading to a greater threat to life for mother and baby. Training for health workers strengthens maternal health services in the community.

#### TIME FOR LEARNING

54%

of homes have no access to clean water and it's mainly women and girls who walk to collect it.

Our programmes reduce the time spent on household chores, giving girls more time for education and small businesses.

#### STOP FGM

Circumcised girls usually marry early and do not complete their education.
The Alternative Rite of Passage (ARP) challenges this practice while still celebrating a girl's 'coming of age' and encouraging communities to keep girls in school.

Girls miss 1 week of school

every month during their
menstruation. A girl without education becomes more vulnerable to

and has limited life choices. Our Girls for Girls programme targets
this and enables girls to remain in school during their menstruation.

Women play a vital role in the communities we work in.

Our programmes put in place interventions to protect girls and women during key moments in their lives from birth through to adulthood.

#### **GDPR**

The General Data Protection Regulation will take effect from May 2018. It replaces the existing law on data protection and gives individuals more rights and protection in how their personal data is used by organisations. Parishes must comply with its requirements, just like any other charity or organisation.

From May 2018, people will need to give consent for their data to be used. They will have rights including that of knowing what data is held about them, of correcting any errors, and the right to be 'forgotten'. The Parish will need to develop a Data Privacy Notice.

In order to comply with the new regulations, the Parish will have to obtain explicit consent from parishioners to hold and use their data. Please be patient with us and respond when we seek this consent. In general your data is used to keep you informed about news, events, activities, services, to send you the PINS, etc. Thank you.
