From the Rector

Dear Friends,

During the season of Lent there is a great sense of expectation and hope, even though there are many difficult days on the path to the cross, before the joy of the Resurrection. We too as a community of faith have weathered difficult days. Last Easter we were still under lockdown, our churches closed. This year we will get the opportunity to celebrate Easter together, as a community. At Easter we remember a love stronger than death, a love that was the perfect sacrifice for sin, God's love for us. In return Jesus asked us to do two things, to love the Lord our God with all our heart and to love our neighbour as ourselves.


