From the Rector

St. Brigid's Day, February 1st, marks a traditional start to spring, even though it usually signals no change to the weather! However it gives us a glimpse of new growth, as the daffodils are starting to emerge, heralding new hope and new life in the natural world.

It is this sign of new growth and lengthening days in late January and early February that, for me, truly marks the start of a new year, with new hope and fresh beginnings. There will be no monthly lunch at the Centre in February. Instead we hope to see you all in your finery at the Theatre Dinner on Saturday 25th February.


Cleaning Rota



The Parish Choir rehearses for upcoming Holy Communion and special services on Monday evenings in the Parish Centre. New members very welcome.






Table Tennis


Funeral at Newcastle Church followed by burial in the churchyard


