Dear friends,

As March arrives, we are continuing on our Lenten path:

I invite you, therefore, in the name of the Lord to observe a holy Lent, by self-examination and repentance; by prayer, fasting, and self-denial; and by reading and meditating on God's holy word.

The introduction to the Ash Wednesday service in the Book of Common Prayer highlights why, as Christians, we observe the season of Lent. We too must carefully keep these days, still our hearts and minds and hear the call to repentance and the assurance of forgiveness that are proclaimed in the gospel. We are invited to observe a holy Lent, through self examination and repentance, prayer, fasting and by reading and meditating on God's Holy Word.

This Lent is obviously different, and difficult, as we cannot meet together. However, though the church buildings have been closed for two months, the church is still open. The church is its people, it is the community that comes together to worship and give thanks, it is us together as a community of faith.

We are aiming to remain connected through our YouTube page, *Newcastle, Newtownmountkennedy, Calary*, with our recorded Sunday services and midweek reflections. Also, through Facebook, through phone calls and through PINS. It is important to stay connected, to stay together as a community of faith, to worship and to love the Lord our God. It is also important to love our neighbours, to support one another. That is the central aspect that has not changed over the last year of this pandemic, that sense of community, of friendship and the need to reach out and help each other, to listen and to care.

While the world around us may have changed but we have not. Covid-19 has not changed who we are, it has not changed how people care for each other, rather it has increased it as each of us realise how much we rely on one and other for support and friendship. As we progress on our national path to gradually ease the lockdowns, we will hopefully emerge as a more caring and reflective society, united through our common experiences.

Private Prayer

Prior to the reopening for religious services in December, Calary Church had been open on Sunday mornings for private prayer. In the current circumstances, with services reverting to online and the large number of people testing positive for Covid 19, Calary will not be reopening at present. This situation is still being kept under review.





Dear Parishioners,

I am writing to you with regards to Newcastle Parish's commitment to Fields of Life.

The Parish commenced support for this marvellous organisation in May 2003. Since then we have paid for the education, each month, of Nine children in Uganda and Rwanda, as well as contributing more than 50% of the finance to the building of the Glendalough School in Uganda in 2005, following much fundraising.

We now find ourselves in a crisis, due to the Pandemic and the increase (to €28.00 per student) in payments required by the Organisation since January 2020.

We have had a small number of donors who have been contributing monthly the full amount but, due to changes in their circumstances - for instance Moving away or Passing away - that we now have only 5 regular donors left.

There is no opportunity to for us to fund raise due to Covid-19 - coffee mornings, jumble sales etc are all stopped, as is the annual Sunday School contribution.

We have outgoings of $\in 28.00 \times 9 = \in 252.00 \text{ per month.}$

Incoming donations €180.00 per month


We need extra funding to continue with our support and are making a special appeal to Parishioners to contribute.


