Calary Bell Tower

Finally, following almost two years of planning, fundraising and hard work, our Bell Tower restoration is complete. The roof and 2nd floor have been completely replaced and the first floor has been repaired. The four pinnacles on the tower have been made secure and the corner stones have been repointed. Recently we were in a position to have the louvres replaced and the beautiful granite stones around the louvers have been repointed. This last step ensures that the tower is watertight and ensures that another couple of generations will safely worship in Calary. We would like to take this opportunity to thank all those involved in whatever way to make this project possible. Many of you dug deep and helped us financially. Many worked tirelessly on the many fundraising events we held. For this we say thank you and extend a welcome to you all to Calary Church.
