A few words from Nisll


Dear Friends,

SISTER MARY KILLEEN'S WORK IN MUKURU, KENYA

The chance of our annual fundraiser taking place this year for Sister Mary's work is extremely slim but Claire Chambers had already planned to do a sponsored skydive for the Rehab centre for street boys in Mukuru. This was to mark her 80th birthday at Easter but it was frustrated by CoVid19. It was rescheduled for 12 September, but again couldn't take place as folks of her vintage have to behave and be sensible up to 13 September. The next available date for the skydive is 17 October, CoVid and weather willing. Let's hope it's third time lucky!! More details will follow.

Life in the Mukuru slums is tough at the best of times. Now with CoVid, it is even tougher - no work, no income, no food. Starvation is a worse killer than the CoVid. The street boys in the Rehab centre are lucky, with a roof over their heads and catching up on their education. The long-awaited tablets finally made it through the layers of bureaucracy, just it time. The boys are loving using them as they work at their own pace and are benefiting with different types of learning. The carpentry class has also been busy — making the normal small things like chairs but now also coffins and isolation barriers. They are also learning how to grow their own vegetables, but 50 teenagers need a mountain of vegetables to stave off hunger
